The National Teaching Council (NTC) is set to release the results of the 2023 Ghana Teacher Licensure Examination (GTLE) 2&3 on Thursday, December 21, 2023.

The performances of candidates in the above subjects were poor. Ten out of Sixty-Three subjects recorded pass rates of less than 50%. Applied Electricity, Electronics and Physics recorded zero percent pass rate.

STATISTICS ON 2023 GTLE 3 (TRADITIONAL SUBJECTS)

The 2023 GTLE 3 has two categories of candidates. These are fresh and re-sit candidates.
